- TANF
- Children with disabilities
- SSI (disability)

What Do I Need to Bring?

Required Documentation

- Child's official birth certificate
- Social Security Card (Required by ISD)
- Child's up-to-date immunization record
- Current proof of income (See Documents Accepted)
- 2 Proofs of residency: current electric bill/gas bill/water bill must be within the Forney ISD attendance boundaries.
- Parent/guardian picture ID
- Proof of Health Insurance

**PROOF OF INCOME
DOCUMENTS ACCEPTED**

- 2018 1040 Income Tax Return
- W-2 (s) for 2018
- 4-6 most current consecutive stubs (of previous month, not month applying)
- TANF (Not food stamps - SNAPs)
- Self - employment
- Child Support
 - Court ordered - or other arrangements made
 - Divorce Decree **WILL NOT** be accepted as proof of child support
- SSI (disability)
- Homeless families are welcome to apply
- Foster families (if currently foster)
